Laura T. Starks, Ph.D., is the George Kozmetsky Centennial Distinguished University Chair and Professor of Finance at the McCombs School of Business, University of Texas at Austin, where she teaches graduate and undergraduate courses on sustainable investing. Her current research focuses on sustainable finance issues, including climate risk and shareholder proxy voting issues, as well as investor expectations and financial decisions. She has won many awards for her research and teaching,

including the 2022 Skandia Research Award on Long-Term Savings for contributions to the field of banking, insurance and financial services and the 2021 Moskowitz Prize for outstanding research in sustainable finance, which is the premier global prize for research in sustainable finance. She has been President of the AFA, SFS, WFA and FMA. She has served on mutual funds' boards of directors, pension fund advisory committees, the Board of Governors of the Investment Company Institute, and advisory committees for the Norwegian Government Pension Fund. She currently serves on advisory boards or committees for AIF Global, FTSE-Russell, Kroner Center for Financial Research, Investment Company Institute, Netspar, Texas Wall Street Women and the PRI (Principles of Responsible Investing), where she is also Chair of the Academic Network Advisory Committee.
